It is usually distributed to our poorer pensioners at Christmas; but sums can be awarded to anyone in the Parish in dire need. If you hear of a household suffering hardship you can contact the trustees via the Parish Clerk.

# The Thorold

The community-owned pub and café in Marston has been closed by Government order. But the Outreach Post Office remains open every Wednesday (0930-1230) and the shop will stay open. Shop opening hours are currently:

Monday – 2pm to 4pm Tuesday – 9am to 5pm Wednesday – 9am to 2pm Thursday – 1pm to 5pm Friday – 12pm to 2pm

Saturday – 9am to 12pm

Sunday – 10am to 1pm

These hours may be extended and simplified, depending on enough volunteers being available to run it. And the range of goods is being expanded.

They can't take payment over the phone or deliver, but you can phone ahead, so orders are ready for collection.
